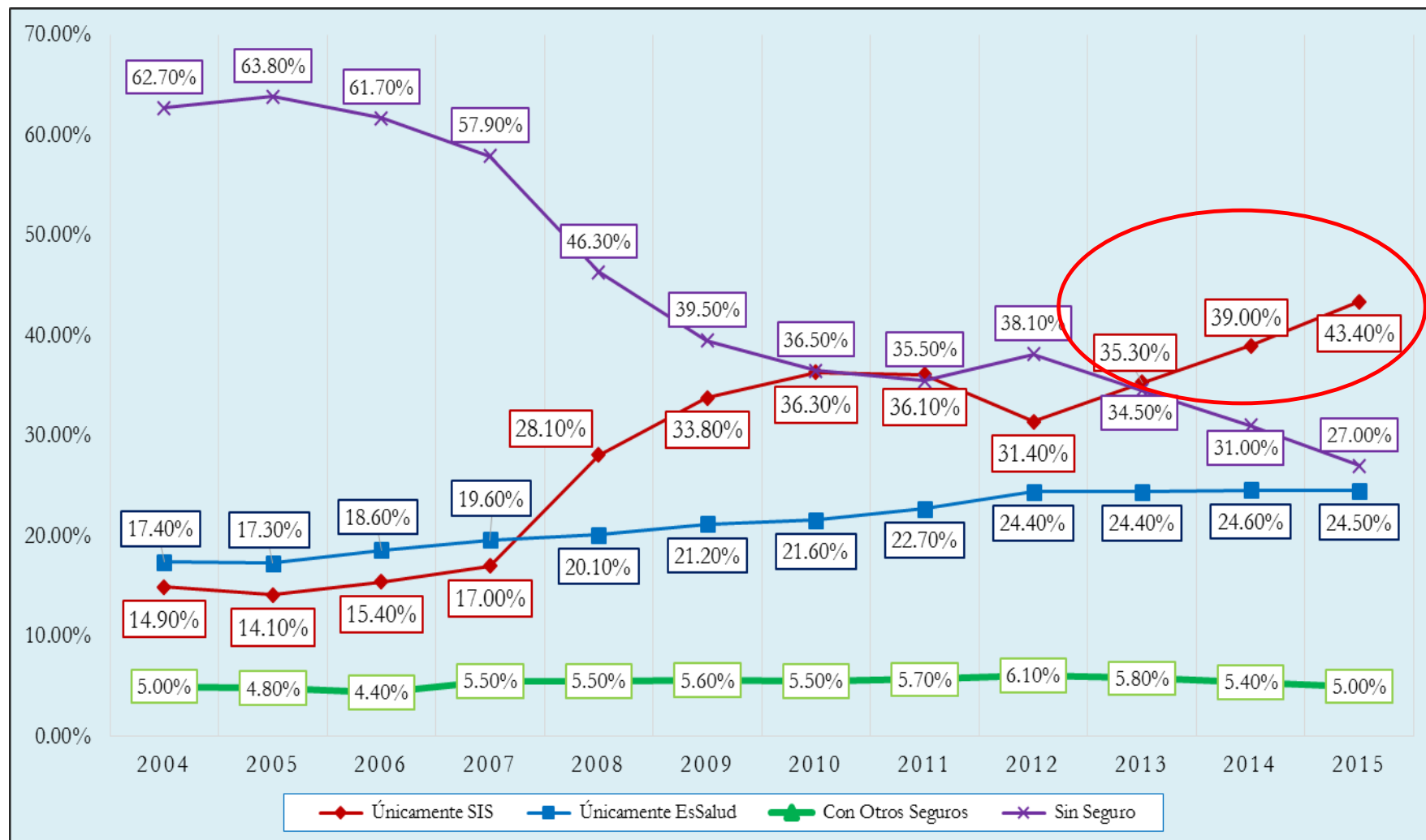

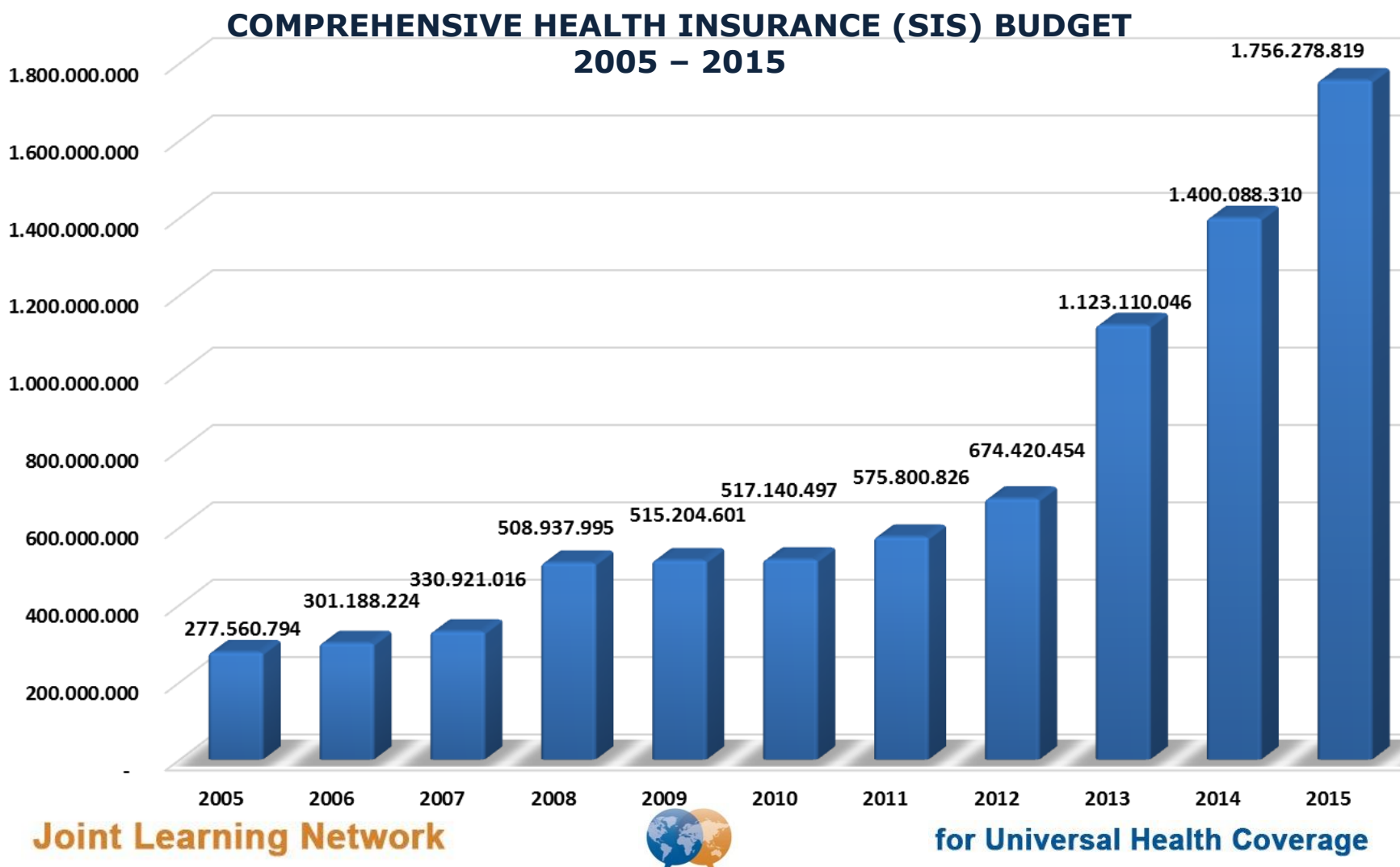
## PROGRESSION OF HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE 2004 – 2015\*

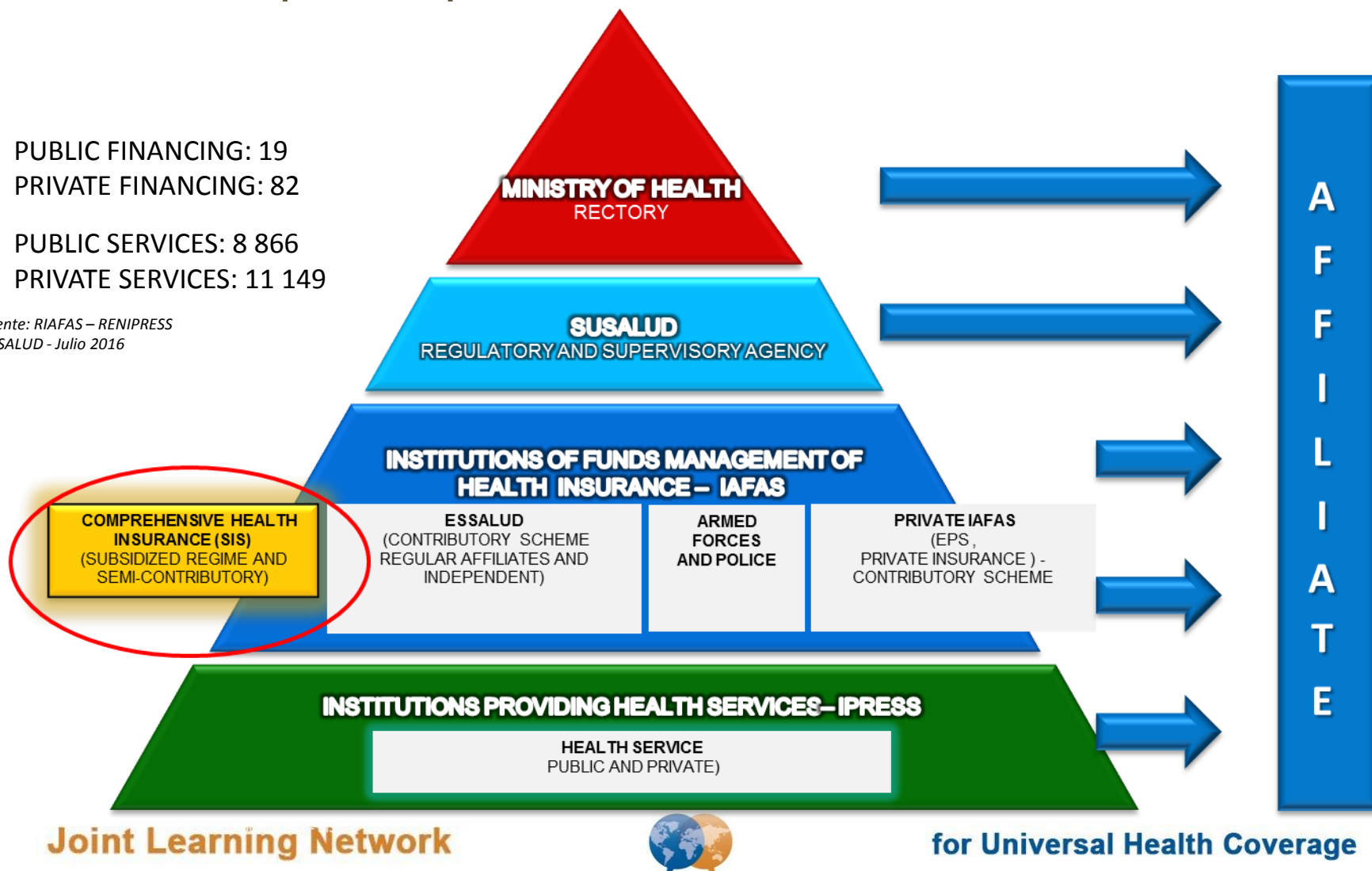

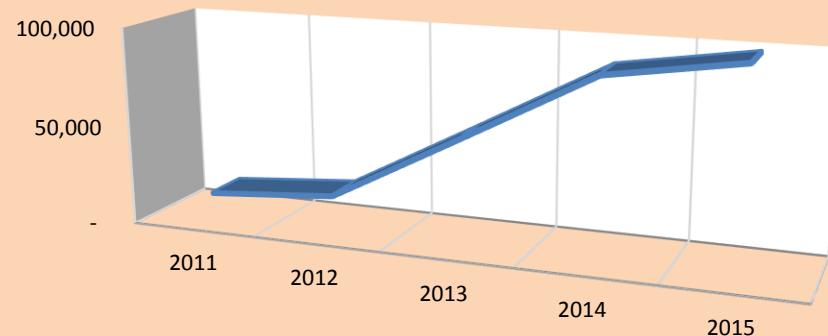

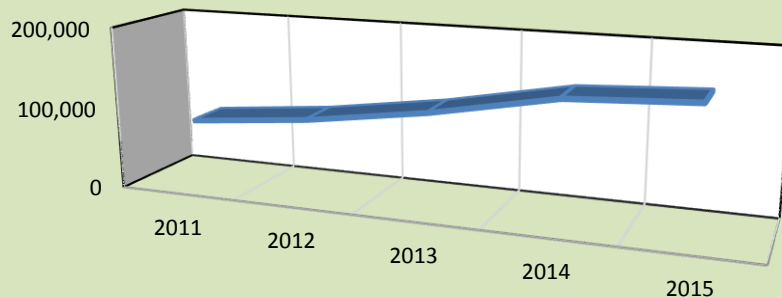
