



PROGRESSION OF HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE 2004 - 2015*





COMPREHENSIVE HEALTH INSURANCE (SIS) TRANSFERS BY LEVEL OF CARE (*)








How is the public/private network structured




What is the main provider payment method


